MEMORANDUM:

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE,

Based on recent and forecasted improved fire weather conditions, the Village of Cuba Fire Department has moved to Stage 1 Fire restrictions for the incorporated areas of the Village of Cuba, and response areas in Sandoval County, until rescinded.

Stage 1 fire restrictions allow for the following activities in the Village of Cuba.:

- Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire or stove fire..
- Welding, or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame.
- Using safe and sane. (Fireworks and other pyrotechnic devices)
- Driving off designated roads. Motorists may park in areas cleared of vegetation within 10 feet of the roadway, or in designated parking areas.

As a result, all agricultural burns will be banned until further notice.

In addition to the ban on open agricultural burning, the sales of fireworks is prohibited in any wild land area in the Village of Cuba, and Sandoval County.

The fire ban and fireworks restrictions will be enforced by the Village of Cuba Fire Marshal and the Cuba Police Department and County Sheriff's Office. Anyone found to be conducting an open agricultural burn or using illegal fireworks will be subject to arrest and or fine. Residents should report illegal burning or fireworks to 505-891-7226.
